# 😲 Legal Basis

**Art. 61***a*<sup>17</sup> Swiss Education Area

- <sup>1</sup> The Confederation and the Cantons shall, within the scope of their powers, jointly ensure the high quality and accessibility of the Swiss Education Area.
- <sup>2</sup> They shall coordinate their efforts and ensure their cooperation through joint administrative bodies and other measures.
- <sup>3</sup> They shall ensure in the fulfilment of their duties<sup>18</sup> that general and vocational courses of study achieve equal recognition in society.



#### Governance



**VPET** system is **collectively governed**: Confederation, the cantons and professional organisations. → Article 1 (**VPETA**)

Vocational and Professional Education and Training Ordinance, (VPETO)




VPETA Art. 59 par. 2: Budgets, allocation of federal funding: [...] As a guideline, the Confederation's share of education funding should be one quarter of public expenditure on the VPET system under this Act. [...]









Costs and benefits by duration of training, in CHF survey year




